





## New book by Vlado Damjanovski: CCTV - with Networking and Digital technology

The best selling CCTV book in the industry (rated 5 stars by many, including Amazon.com), and often referred to as "The CCTV Bible," by our editor, publisher, consultant and trainer - Vlado Damjanovski, is now getting even better and more complete. The publisher Elsevier (Butterworth Heinemann) has contracted the author to write a new and extended edition, with new chapters on Digital and Networking in CCTV. The original chapters on Analogue CCTV are still there, although they have also been revised and updated.

In addition to Digital and Networking, this new edition contains also a new chapter on video testing using the CCTV Labs test chart, as well as the CCTV Labs test pattern generator, which are becoming standard tools in the industry. The new version of the CCTV Labs test chart is printed on the back of this hard covered book, which is traditionally being put there, so that readers can use the book as a testing tool also.
