


World's largest digital matrix surveillance system in the world's largest casino: The Venetian Macau

Dallmeier International Ltd., a joint venture between Australian company, CR Kennedy and Company and Dallmeier electronic GmbH & Co., of Germany, has been awarded a multi-million dollar contract to supply and commission the world's largest digital matrix surveillance system in the world's largest casino; The Venetian Macau.

The Venetian Macau Casino Resort, a Las Vegas Sands Corp., development, is the third international casino contract awarded CR Kennedy and Company. The Venetian was won through the success of previous installations by the company for Stages One and Two of the Las Vegas Sands Corp., casino development - The Sands Macau which opened in 2004.

The Venetian's digital matrix surveillance system will be the single largest installation on one site, and will comprise over 3000 cameras and 30 operator workstations. When completed the total system will have in excess of 7000 video inputs.

The joint venture, Dallmeier International Limited, was formed to facilitate The Venetian project as Stephen Beard, Managing Director Dallmeier International Limited and Director, CR Kennedy explains.

"CR Kennedy's experience in Australia with Crown Casino (Melbourne), Star City (Sydney) and Burswood (Perth) enabled us to undertake The Sands project independently however, the sheer size of The Venetian Macau required us to work with a partner. As Dallmeier electronic's distributor in Australia it was a natural extension of the relationship to form the joint venture; we have the experience in casinos

and the Asian market, Dallmeier is the manufacturer."

The original Sands project facilitated by CR Kennedy also involved Dallmeier electronic. "The client (Las Vegas Sands Corp.) wanted a virtual matrix system for The Sands Macau. At that time the technology didn't exist. CR Kennedy and Dallmeier electronic worked together to develop the system which we built from the ground up," says Beard.

Currently under construction The Venetian Macau, a \$US1.8 billion development mirroring its Las Vegas namesake, is the anchor property of the Cotai Strip™ of Macau – Asia's Las Vegas™. It is scheduled to open in 2007.

The complexity of the monitoring system for The Venetian Macau, which spans 10.5 million sqft, 546,000 sqft of which is gaming floor, has once again called for the development of new technology to create recording and storage facilities capable of handling this immense CCTV system.

"Dallmeier International has provided The Venetian Macau not only with a CCTV solution, but technological and professional expertise to the challenging and changing business of Casino operations in the most dynamic gaming environment in the world," says William F Bonar, Director of Surveillance, Venetian Macau Limited.

Commissioning of the project will commence in September 2006 and will be managed through Dallmeier International's Hong Kong office. [•]
